GUIDELINES for the ANNUAL MUD VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT

The tournament is held at 1301 E. Siebenthaler Ave. behind Wegerzyn Gardens. (at back of property)

All teams must be pre-registered, assigned a court and have wristbands by the day of event.

Captain's meeting held prior to event at Frickers on Woodman Dr. (date and time will be posted on website)

Gates open at 7:00 am.

Captain's meeting 8:30 am. in front of flatbed

Tournament play begins at 9:00 am sharp.

Team captains only should check in with their ref on their court when they arrive. Give team # to ref.

This year will feature competitive and non-competitive brackets. There will be a total of 9 trophies earned. Seven trophies will go to the competitive teams based on seeding and 2 trophies for the non-competitive post pool-play tournament. We would like to remind people that this tournament is for fun and to support a good cause.

Players must be 16 years of age.

All teams must be co-ed with two members of each gender on the court at all times.

Teams registration consist of 10 players.

Each team must assign a captain who will assure that all **Rules of Play and Guidelines** are followed by their team members at all time. Any unruly or inappropriate behavior will be cause for teams to be ejected from the tournament and the park.

Captain's must submit the following:

Team Roster — include t-shirt size for each player-

Must also have addresses for each player or registration will be incomplete and not accepted

Release of Liability forms signed by each player with a witness signature must be submitted to EFWO to receive entry wristbands for all players to get into and play in the event.

Spectators donation \$5.00 for all ages. Children must be supervised at all times and are not permitted on the courts. All spectators waive liability by attending the event.

Food, drink and beer will be available for purchase on site. Per state law, **No alcohol may be brought into the park. ALL COOLERS AND BAGS WILL BE INSPECTED** by security and alcohol will be confiscated. Please do not bring it in. All bottles will be inspected so don't try to hide it in other containers.

Warning: If you are going to drink beer, please arrange for a designated driver. Law enforcement officers are prepared to arrest anyone *driving under the influence* as you depart from the park.

We provide changing tents and an outdoor (lake water) shower to wash off the mud . Don't forget to bring towels and a bag for wet clothes. NO one is allowed in the Lake.

Shoes with covered toes are required. It is advised to duct tape them around your feet to keep them on.

NO PARKING allowed by the courts. All vehicles must remain in the parking lot or teams will be disqualified. This will be enforced.

Bring lawn chairs/blankets, shade, games etc. There will be down time between matches.

Enclosed tents and grills are not permitted.

We suggest you have someone supervise jewelry, money and keys while playing. **We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.**

Team members can check the board outside the front gate to find out which court you are assigned to play on. Team # is on wristbands.

No team registrations the day of the event. No refunds given for any reason. Games are played rain or shine (unless lightening)
